## Academic Program Review Schedule

The policy for academic program reviews at Indiana University Southeast calls for programs to undergo reviews at intervals of 7-10 years. Note that the policy document is available at this website. The schedule below indicates the academic year in which the review of each academic program is to commence. The schedule is organized in two ways: by school and program, and by year. The time line for reviews that is set out in the policy document envisions that reviews will be completed in 12-15 months. Each program that is undergoing review establishes a time line as part of its planning process, and progress in completing reviews is monitored by the dean of the appropriate school and by the Office of Academic Affairs.
