**Chancellor's Medallion Leadership
Awards**

The Board of Advisors of Indiana University Southeast will present two 2006 Chancellor's Medallion Leadership Awards (\$3,000 each) to currently enrolled IUS students for tuition assistance during the 2006-07 academic year.

Purpose of the award is to recognize and encourage student participation and leadership in academic, extra-curricular, and co-curricular activities.

Criteria:

Any currently enrolled full-time IUS student who will be a senior in the 2006-07 academic year is eligible. Selection will be based upon (a) current and past record of extracurricular activities; (b) community and volunteer accomplishments; and (c) academic achievement (minimum GPA 3.3).
