



Useful Statistical Sources Online

For Indiana statistics:

www.stats.indiana.edu

Click on "Indiana Profiles," then on "In-Depth Profiles"

Choose county or region and click "go"

Scroll down until you find the data you want (Click on "More Data" at end of box for additional statistics.)

OR Create a customized region (for example, Floyd and Clark counties), by clicking "Customize" and highlighting desired counties while holding down Control key. Click "Go" etc.

For Kentucky statistics:

Select "Kentucky Stats"

For all types of U.S. national and regional statistics, including business:

From www.census.gov click on "American FactFinder" (on left)

In the "Basic Facts" box at top of page,

Select a type of data, a place, and a state, and click "Go"

For statistics about *your* neighborhood (local census tract):

From www.census.gov

Click on "American FactFinder" (on left)

Click on the blue notation "Enter a street address" in the upper left corner. Fill in the address boxes and click "Go." Highlight the

bottom line, (or one of the lines above for a larger view), and click "Go."

Click on desired data. To get a census map of your neighborhood, click on "Map it"
