REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY

1. Applicants must be admitted to Indiana University Southeast as a fully qualified undergraduate student planning to enroll during the 2012-13 academic year.
2. Applicants must complete and submit the M^cPheeters Scholarship Application.
3. Applicants must have a minimum high school or college cumulative GPA. of 2.5.
4. Graduating high school seniors must have a minimum ACT Composite of 21 or SAT of 1000 (Verbal + Math).
5. Applicants must complete a 500 word essay on *Why is diversity important when pursuing your education and how will I contribute to diversity at Indiana University Southeast?*.
6. Applicants must attach at least one letter of recommendation from a counselor, teacher or community leader.
7. Applicants must provide a listing of volunteer experiences, extra-curricular or leadership activities you have participated in or are currently involved.

Complete a 500 word essay on the following topic, *Why is diversity important when pursuing your education and how will I contribute to diversity at Indiana University Southeast?*.

The mission of Indiana University Southeast is to provide high-quality educational programs and services that promote student learning and prepare students for productive citizenship in a diverse society, and to contribute to the intellectual, cultural, and economic development of the region. IU Southeast is committed to the recruitment and retention of students from underrepresented populations. The campus is committed to offering educational programs and services which promote and support diversity in all its aspects.

The M^cPheeters Multicultural Scholarship is a competitive, up to four-year renewable award, contingent upon continuous enrollment at IU Southeast and a minimum cumulative IU Southeast GPA of 2.5 or better. The award amount can range between \$1,000.00 to \$250.00 per semester based the total number of enrolled credit hours per Fall and Spring semesters. Awards will be made based on the applicant's ranking within the competitive pool. Please note that offers will only be made to undergraduate multicultural students who have been admitted to Indiana University Southeast.

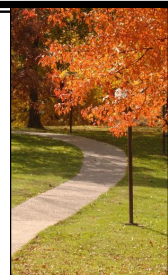
