

## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**Elementary Education Program, School of Education, Indiana University Southeast  
And  
Elementary Education Program, Ivy Tech Community College of Southern Indiana**

The Elementary Education Program in the School of Education at Indiana University Southeast (IUS) and the Elementary Education Program at Ivy Tech Community College of Southern Indiana (ITCC) agree to an articulation agreement. Ivy Tech students who graduate with an Associate of Science in Education, Elementary Education Concentration (ELEAS) degree may matriculate to the Elementary Education Program in the School of Education at IU Southeast utilizing IUS established criteria for acceptance. Upon successful completion of that program, IUS will recommend to the Indiana Department of Education that the candidates be awarded a license as Generalist: Elementary Education (grades kindergarten through fifth).

The specific courses that will transfer between the two institutions and specific assurances to be met by both programs are attached. The coordinators for elementary education and the deans at both institutions will monitor all assurances and the exchange of data between the two programs. A maximum of 60 credit hours will transfer to IUS.

This agreement represents a formal collaboration of IUS School of Education and ITCC Education Program regarding articulation of the ELEAS Program at ITCC to IUS, beginning November, 2007. Coursework taken prior to November, 2007 will be evaluated by IUS program faculty on a course-by-course basis to determine appropriate transferability. Limits may be placed on courses accepted under this agreement should the student subsequently decide to change to another program not covered by this agreement.

## **ASSURANCES - ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**

### **Elementary Education Program, School of Education, Indiana University Southeast And Education-Elementary Program, Ivy Tech Community College of Southern Indiana**

The following assurances recommended by the Teacher Education Committee (TEC) of the Indiana Department of Education are part of this articulation agreement and will be reviewed annually by the individuals monitoring the programs at ITCC and IUS.

- ITCC will create an Education Advisory Committee (EAC) made up of stakeholders from the education community (School corporations and private educational systems), faculty from IUS and ITCC, and others deemed necessary by the established committee.
- The EAC will meet once a semester.
- A member of EAC will serve on the Council on Preparing Education Professionals (COPEP) of the IUS School of Education.
- IUS and ITCC will jointly collect data according to the Unit Assessment System for the licensure of Generalist: Elementary Education by IUS.
- IUS and ITCC Deans, practicing teachers, and relevant faculty will meet at least once a semester to review the data and to make any necessary program changes indicated by the data.
- The data will be reported to the EAC at each scheduled meeting with recommendations by the EAC made to both faculties.
- Coordinators or other relevant faculty members from IUS and ITCC will be invited to participate in each program's retreats, faculty meetings, professional development opportunities, or other activities pertinent to effective communication between the two institutions.
- Candidates at ITCC will be eligible to attend all workshops or other remediation procedures in preparation for Praxis I or the PPST (a requirement of entry into the Elementary Education Program).
