IUS International Programs

David Hershberg Scholarship for international study

Sponsored by the World Affairs Council of Kentucky & Southern Indiana

- Amount: up to \$2,000
- Application deadlines: February 18, 2011.
- Eligibility: Full time degree seeking student currently enrolled in a degree program at any accredited institution of higher learning in Metro Louisville
- Details: Scholarship funds of can be used to help defray the costs of international travel, lodging, and maintenance for a period of at least 21 days of study or research outside the United States.

David Hershberg Scholarship for international study

Application Process:

Three (3) copies of each of the following materials are required:

- Resume
- Personal statement (maximum 500 words)
- Travel itinerary and estimated budget
- Two (2) letters of recommendation
- An official transcript

Boren Scholarships

- Amount:
 - \$8,000 for a summer program
 - \$10,000 for a semester
 - \$20,000 for a full academic year
- Application deadlines: February 10, 2011
- Eligibility: U.S. undergraduate students to study abroad in areas of the world that are critical to U.S. interests and underrepresented in study abroad.
- Details: Boren Scholars represent a variety of academic backgrounds, but all are interested in studying less commonly taught languages, including but not limited to Arabic, Chinese, Korean, Portuguese, Russian, and Swahili.

The Ed Quinn/David Starr Jordan Scholarship Fund

- Amount: \$250-\$1500
- Application deadlines: March 1 for fall programs and October 15 for spring/summer programs
- Application process: complete online application and instructions at <http://www.ius.edu/intprograms/academicgrants.cfm>

Counsel on International Education Exchange

- Amount: varies upon program length and destination
- Application deadlines:
 - April 1—summer, fall, and academic year programs
 - November 1—winter, spring and calendar year programs
- Eligibility: Scholarship applicants must also have a complete program application on file with CIEE by the scholarship deadlines in order to be considered.
- Details: Scholarships are available for a wide variety of programs and countries.
- Application process: A complete scholarship application must be submitted with a 500-word, typed scholarship essay.

Institute for International Education

- Amount: up to **\$2.15 million** in scholarships and financial aid are offered each year, individual amount varies upon program length and destination
- Application deadlines:
 - Fall: May 3
 - Spring: October 25
 - Summer: April 1
- Eligibility: Scholarship applicants must also have a complete program application on file with IES by the scholarship deadlines in order to be considered.
- Application process: Go to www.iesabroad.org for application forms and procedures

Minority Scholarships

- Amount: Scholarship amounts range from \$275 for short-term programs, from \$750 to \$1,000 for summer programs, from \$1,000 to \$1,250 for semester programs, and \$1,500 to \$2,500 for academic year programs.
- Application deadlines: Varies by program—usually November for spring programs and February for summer/fall programs.
- Details: Overseas Study offers scholarships to underrepresented U.S. racial/ethnic minority undergraduates from any IU campus. Financial need and academic performance are considered.

Program Specific Scholarships

- Amount: Scholarship amounts range from \$500-\$750 for short-term programs, from \$750 to \$1,000 for semester programs, and \$1,500 to \$2,250 for academic year programs.
- Application deadlines: Varies by program—usually November for spring programs and February for summer/fall programs.
- Details: Scholarships awarded by Overseas Study are based on both financial need and academic merit.

Fulbright Scholarships

- Two Categories
 - Teaching Assistantships
 - Study/Research Abroad
- Application deadline: mid-October
- Eligibility
 - Senior Undergraduate Student
 - US Citizen
- Details
 - Scholarship
 - Usual one academic year in length
 - After undergraduate graduation and before starting graduate program
 - Follows academic calendar of host university

Fulbright Scholarships

- Facility with language of host country an asset
- Applicant responsible for securing affiliations in host country
- Study/Research Fellowships
 - University coursework
 - Independent library or field research
 - Professional training in the Arts
- Application process: Applications are evaluated at the campus level by a committee. Committee submits evaluation of proposal to Fulbright.

Other Financial Aid Options

A wide variety of scholarship, grant and loan opportunities can be used to support study abroad.

- **Apply for IU Financial Aid.**
- **IU Scholarships and Loans.** The scholarships, grants, subsidized and unsubsidized loans that you normally receive for study at IU through Student Financial Assistance may be used to pay for study abroad.
- **Edward L. Hutton International Experiences Program (HIEP).** Grants are made on a competitive basis.
- **IU 21st Century Scholars Covenant Study Abroad Grants.** Summer grants provide special supplemental financial assistance on a competitive basis.
