

Your Next Steps – Transfer Students

Before Advising and Registration

Create an IU computing account.

Students admitted for spring (January): Beginning November 14, students admitted for *spring* will be able to create their IU computing username and passphrase.

Students admitted for fall (August): Beginning in mid-March, students admitted for *fall* will be able to create their IU computing username and passphrase.

Visit the Account Management Service at <https://itaccounts.iu.edu>. You will need your University Identification Number which is listed on your Certificate of Admission. Your network identification will give you access to OneStart (<https://onestart.iu.edu>), which you will use to register for classes, manage your university financial accounts, and more. PLEASE NOTE: If you set up an IU guest account to check your admission status, you must set up a new IU computing account in order to register for classes and manage your student record.

View transfer credit.

If you are bringing in credits from another college, you can view your credit transfer report after creating your network computing account username and passphrase. You may view your Transfer Credit Report on OneStart on the self-service tab. If you have questions about the transfer of credits, please call the Admissions Office at 812-941-2212.

Advising and Registration

Schedule an advising appointment.

Transfer students must call the academic school listed on their Certificate of Admission for advising and registration. If you did not transfer college level English or math credits to IU Southeast (see your transfer credit report), you will need to take placement tests before your advising appointment.
