



Dear future Grove Grizzly, Orchard Owl, Forest Falcon, Meadow Moose, or Woodland Wolf:

Welcome to IU Southeast! August 25, 2011 is your day to move into IU Southeast's lodge-style residence halls. Check-in at the lodges will begin at 9:00 a.m. You will go to the lodge to which you have been assigned for check-in.

As you prepare to move on to campus, please keep the following things in mind:

- Pack lightly. We recommend that you do not bring everything you own right away. You may find it helpful to bring only your seasonal wardrobe and then swap out your warm weather clothing for cold weather clothing in October or November. You might also want to talk to your roommates ahead of time so you do not end up with four toasters and no TV.
- Arrive before 1:00 p.m. Each lodge will be hosting their first lodge meeting at 2 p.m. the day of move-in. This meeting is full of important information as well as your first opportunity to meet the majority of your lodge-mates. You won't want to miss a minute of it!
- Remember your computer. The lodges are all hard-wired with internet connections, and each lodge has wireless internet access available throughout all student living and public spaces. You need to make sure your computer is ready for campus connectivity. Check out the information technology resource page at www.ius.edu/it to make sure your computer will work properly on campus. Additionally, staff from the IT Help Desk will be available to assist at move in.
- Carry your student ID. When you check in, you will need to show your student ID. The lodges require a special ID card for entry. We will check your ID to make sure that you have the special entry card and replace it if you do not. The Bursar's office will be open to make IDs if you do not have one yet. If you need an ID, make that office your first stop before checking into your lodge.
- Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle. Remember the environment when you are packing. While we will have extra dumpsters for trash, we hope you will save some of your packing materials and boxes to reuse them at the end of the year.
- Bring some key items with you. You will want to only use blue, painter's masking tape to hang up posters; this will help avoid doing damage to the walls. To make cleaning easier, we recommend bringing aluminum foil to wrap the drip-pans under your stove burners and to line the bottom of your oven. You'll also want to bring a spray carpet cleaner to help you clean up any spills and a mattress pad, too, as we do not provide these items in student rooms.

Parking around the lodges will be limited. When you arrive, you will drop off your belongings and move your vehicle to designated parking areas. Please do not bring moving trucks or trailers as they will be difficult to maneuver in some of our parking areas. We also do not allow hand-trucks/dollies inside the lodges as they can damage the walls or flooring, so we recommend leaving those at home as well.

We have some wonderful activities in store for you this year as well as some excellent leadership opportunities. Look for the posting of upcoming events on your fridge when you move in, and be sure to check the calendars in the lobby of each lodge throughout the year to learn about all the great events to attend or ways to get involved on campus. For those of you really looking to make a difference, keep an eye out for information about our Lodge Council, the student governing group that plans activities for students living on campus.

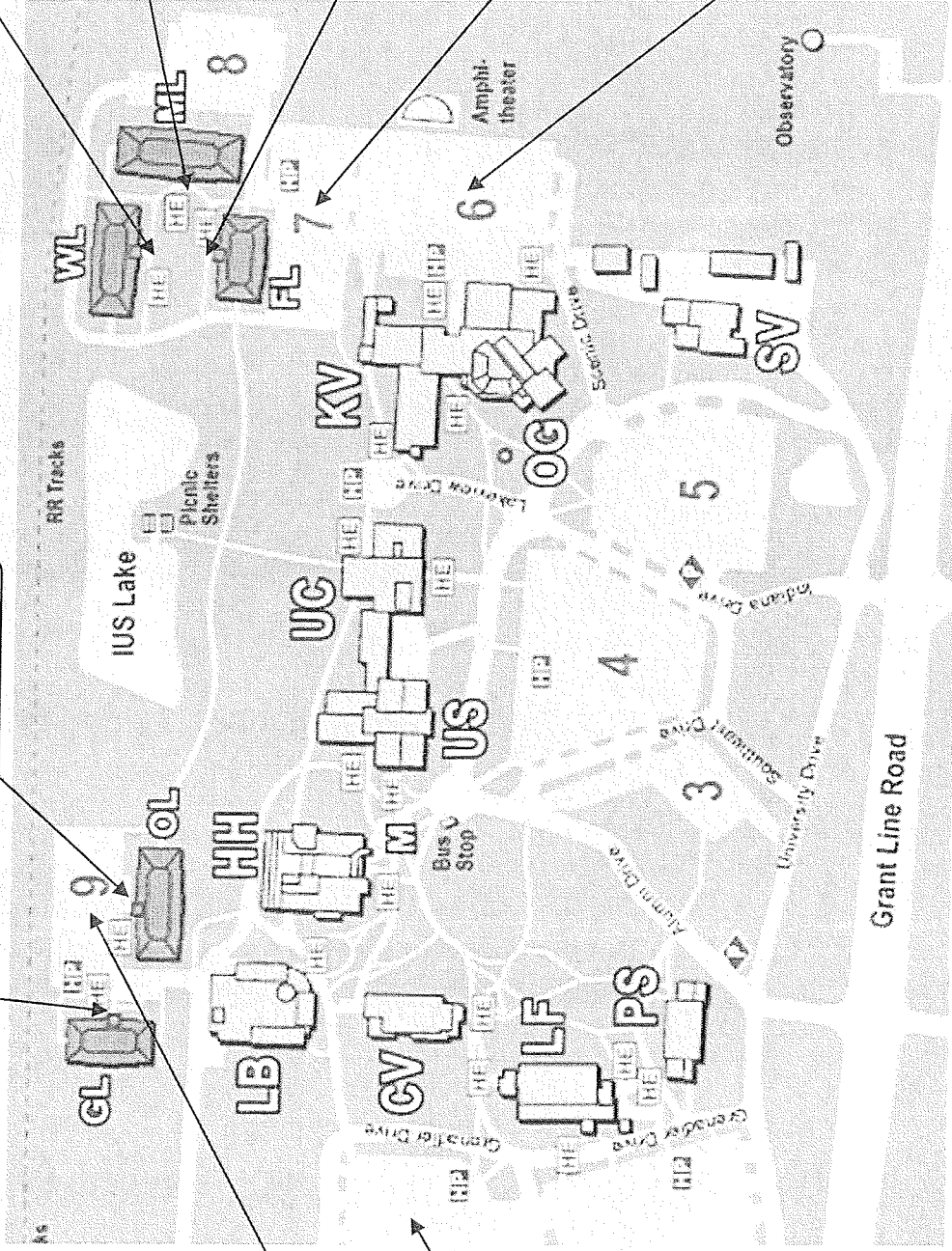

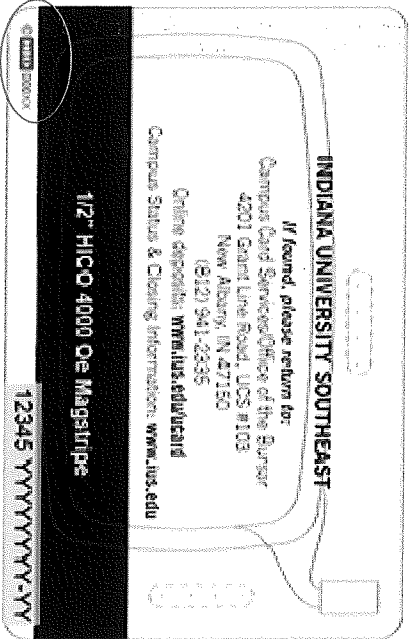

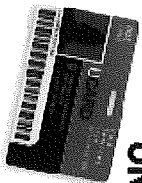
Hello and welcome to IU Southeast!

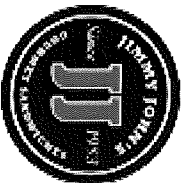


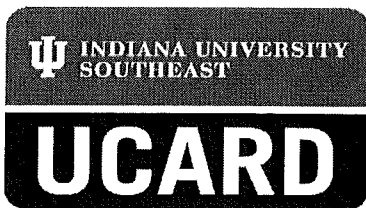

Meal Plan for Indiana University Southeast

Please visit our website at www.ius.edu/ucard to see our policies and procedures.

Dining points can only be used in the University Grounds Coffee Shop and The Food Court, located on the ground floor of the University Center South building and the Library Bistro located on the ground floor of the Library building.

Dining points may be purchased in various amounts to suit your dining needs. Please check the plan you wish to purchase:

- \$50.00 = 52 points (earns an additional **free 2 points or 4% savings**)
- \$100.00 = 105 points (earns an additional **free 5 points or 5% savings**)
- \$300.00 = 330 points (earns an additional **free 30 points or 10% savings**)
- \$400.00 = 450 points (earns an additional **free 50 points or 13% savings**)
- \$600.00 = 690 points (earns an additional **free 90 points or 15% savings**)

Policies:

- Meal plan points may be rolled over during the academic year. Points will expire August 31 if a new meal plan for the next academic year is not purchased between July 1 and August 31.
- Points may ONLY be used in the University Grounds Coffee Shop, the Food Court, and the Library Bistro.
- Faculty & Staff points will roll over as long as they are employed by IUS.

Employee Meal Plans

Like the student meal plan, employees can open an employee meal plan by contacting the Bursars office. The employee meal plan provides for the same "bonus points" program as listed above. The employee meal plans begin immediately upon opening and continue until used. You have seven days from the last day of employment to use your points; after seven days your points will expire.
