The Frank C. Denzinger Scholarship in Criminal Justice is an award for a student who will be attending IU Southeast in pursuit of a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice. Preference will be given to those candidates who are civic minded and committed to making his or her community a safer place. They will have exhibited a concern for others in their community and in the world through their activities.

## Criteria:

- The recipient must be enrolled, or be a high-school student accepted to pursue, either full or part-time studies at IU Southeast pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice.
- Preference will be given to an individual who is currently employed as a full-time law enforcement officer, corrections officer or jail officer; or
- to a student who is the son or daughter of an individual who is currently employed (or has retired, in good standing) as a full-time law enforcement officer, corrections officer, or jail officer.
- Preference given to those students who are civic minded and have shown a commitment to community involvement through membership in the Fraternal Order of Police, Knights of Columbus, Masons, etc.
- Preference given to those students who have at least 2 years of full-time law enforcement work experience.

- listing of membership in community organizations
- statement of relationship to a law enforcement officer, corrections officer or jail officer if not employed
- 2 letters of recommendation – one must be from direct supervisor if employed as an officer
- brief statement of philosophy of public service if currently employed as an officer
- submit current resume if employed as an officer

The scholarship will be renewable up to \$1,500 and will be distributed annually. The amount and recipient(s) will be chosen by the appropriate Scholarship Committee.
