

Delay or Cancellation of Class Meetings due to Adverse Weather Conditions

Classes at IU Southeast operate as scheduled unless a specific announcement of a delay or cancellation is made.

If the chancellor or a designated representative decides that weather conditions are so hazardous that morning classes should be delayed, an announcement will be made on the campus web site and area television stations to follow the "SNOW SCHEDULE" as follows.

Monday through Friday:

8:00 a.m. classes meet at 10:00 a.m. for 50 minutes

9:30 a.m. classes meet at 11:00 a.m. for 50 minutes

11:00 a.m. classes meet at 12:00 Noon for 50 minutes

Saturday:

9:00 a.m. classes meet at 10:30 a.m. for 90 minutes

When the Snow Schedule is in effect, students and faculty members should **not** come to the campus before 10:00 a.m. to avoid interfering with snow removal from walkways and parking lots.

If weather conditions deteriorate during the day, a decision may be made to cancel evening classes. For this purpose, an evening class is any class that starts before 6 pm but is still in session at 6 pm, as well as any class that starts at 6 pm or thereafter.

If conditions are so hazardous that classes cannot be held, it will be announced via the web site and radio and television stations that the campus is CLOSED and only those personnel designated as essential should report. If the campus is closed, off-campus classes are also cancelled. If an off-campus class is offered at a public school or other facility that is closed due to weather, the class is cancelled even if the IUS campus is open. Note that decisions about whether IUS is open are not linked to decisions about the opening or closing of the public schools in the region.
