MINIMUM OVERALL GRADUATE GPA: 3.0

All coursework applied to your Masters degree must be completed within 6 years. No more than 9 hours of graduate coursework taken prior to admission to the Masters program will be counted toward the degree (effective Fall 05).

Program requirements may change and you may be subject to new guidelines if you do not take coursework for more than one year.

If petitioned and approved, up to 6 credit hours (grade of B or higher) may be allowed from other institutions; up to 15 credit hours from other IU campuses. Petition forms are available from the School of Education.

You must file an application for degree and other necessary paperwork at least six months prior to the intended date of graduation. University graduation periods are May, August, and December. Students completing requirements in the summer will graduate on August 31st.
