Please note: the University awards academic minors where coursework may not meet state requirements for teaching minors. Candidates adding one or more teaching minors must earn at least a 2.00 (C) in each course and have an overall grade-point-average of 2.75 (on a 4.00 scale) in each minor. Consult with your Secondary academic program advisor. Substitutions must be approved, signed, and dated by a Secondary Education advisor.
