

# **Program Admission**

## **Admission Requirements**

Acceptance without conditions requires candidates to:

1. Apply and be accepted for Graduate Studies.
2. Submit an approved plan for program completion.
3. Pass a criminal history check.
4. Provide verification of the exact license needed for current job.
5. Submit original transcripts for course work applicable to the program.
6. Have an undergraduate GPA of 2.5 or better.
7. Have PRAXIS I (PPST: Pre-professional Skills Test) scores of at least 176 in Reading, 175 in Mathematics, and 172 in Writing.

## **Application Procedure**

To initiate the application procedure, interested individuals should contact the program coordinator (812-941-2466) to make an appointment. Transcripts should be brought to the advising appointment.

Though applications are accepted throughout the year, it is critical for candidates with emergency or provisional licenses to start coursework immediately after being hired by a district.
