

To apply for scholarships at IU Southeast:

1. Complete on-line scholarship application beginning October 1 at www.ius.edu/financialaid/ScholarshipsGrants.cfm. Application must be submitted by January 29 for priority consideration.
2. Submit FAFSA to maximize eligibility (school code 001817) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The FAFSA application must be received no later than February 15 by IU Southeast. If waiting to file taxes please contact the Financial Aid Office for additional information.
3. Decide if you would like to submit essay for additional scholarship opportunities. Essay should be submitted on-line by clicking on the Essay and Resume of Activities Worksheet at www.ius.edu/financialaid/ScholarshipsGrants.cfm.
4. If submitting essay also complete on-line resume of activities and awards by clicking on the Essay and Resume of Activities Worksheet at www.ius.edu/financialaid/ScholarshipsGrants.cfm.
5. If submitting essay an essay the student must also request three (3) letters of recommendation from a mentor, teacher, counselor or employer. Letters of recommendation should be collected by the student and submitted together to the Financial Aid Office.
6. Check with your Academic Division regarding scholarship opportunities and applications. Not all scholarships are awarded by the Financial Aid Office so contact your academic division directly for applications and deadline.
7. Check with local agencies and community foundations for scholarship opportunities.
