- ✓ Follow required format: Put title on first page; number pages; double space (poetry can be single spaced); indent paragraphs; use Times New Roman 12 pt. font.
- ✓ Flash fiction must be no more than 500 words.
- ✓ Submit all entries by May 15, 2009.
