Dual Credit with IU Southeast:



- **Advanced College Project:** Eligible high school students take courses with certified IU high school teacher at their school to earn college credit.
- **Bridge to College: Eligible** high school seniors take classes taught by IUS faculty at their high school or at IUS to earn college-level credit.
