

## STUDENT ACTIVITY FEES FUNDING POLICIES

MANAGED BY THE STUDENT LIFE COMMITTEE

- 1. Student Activity Fee Funded Activities: Student activities and athletic programs are important aspects of the University's educational process. As a result, Student Activity Fee accounts are established to provide financial support for student groups that meet the following criteria:
  - A. The group or activity is recognized by the University as providing the campus with those cultural, recreational, social and athletic programs essential to a well-rounded student life and,
  - B. The group or activity does not endorse a particular religious, political, or ideological point of view.
  - C. Any group seeking funding from Student Activity Fees must review this policy and complete an "Student Organization/Activity Funding Application" which can be obtained from and submitted to the Office of Campus Life in the University Center. The Office of Campus Life will forward this completed application to the Office of Student Affairs for Student Life Committee consideration.
- 2. New Student Groups: Approved and chartered special interest groups (new registered student organizations) are eligible for a one-time start-up allocation (\$50) that may, during an initial period of organizational development, be used for supplies and expense items to promote awareness of the group on campus. A group may contact the Office of Campus Life for a "Student Organization Request for \$50 Seed Money" form; the group must state how and when funding would be used. The Associate Director of Campus Life will complete the "verification section" of the form and submit it to the Student Life Committee for consideration.
- **3. Ineligible Groups:** Groups that do not meet the criteria above for an account, and are Registered Student Organizations may apply for a "*Registered Student Organization Grant*."
